PACT works directly with military service members to match their companion animals with appropriate foster homes that will give them the care and love they need while their military owners are deployed. We facilitate the foster home placement via our Military Foster Agreement – a written agreement that outlines the terms of the relationship and protects the interests of all parties involved. During the foster term, PACT remains in close contact with the foster home to ensure the pet is in a loving and safe environment, and we continue to work with the foster home caregivers to solve any issues or concerns that may arise.

While the military owner is deployed, the foster family provides owners with regular updates – at least one per month – on their pet's well being, recent activities and care in the foster's home by emails, texts, photographs and/or video.

PACT's Military Foster Program is unique in that after the pet's owner returns home and they are reunited, the foster family can exercise the option for reasonable visitation rights with the pet.

PACT is always seeking additional foster homes, military companion animals that require a foster home, and donations to further all the free services provided by PACT.
